Unification

A European civilisation-state and a genuine European federation.



Repatriation

Decisive enforcement of return for those without legal right to remain.



Reindustrialisation

A common economic framework, including a 28th regime, and a truly unified single market.



Civilisation & Sovereignty

European civilisation is worth defending — and Europe must have the sovereignty to do so.



Remilitarisation

A common defence with joint command, control, communications, and intelligence.

The 2029 Objective

Build an electable pan-European force before 2029

By the 2029 European Parliament Elections, Ave Europa will be registered as a political party in every EU member state — contesting regional, national, and European elections under a single continental brand.





The Road to 2029

From grassroots mobilisation to European political leverage

2025

Movement launched

Ave Europa established in March 2025 as a popular, bottom-up Europeanist movement.

2025–26

Founding organisations

NGOs and associations established across Denmark, Germany, Netherlands, Spain, Poland and the UK — with more chapters in progress.

2026–27

Political parties registered

Launch of formal political parties under the Ave Europa brand to shape policy directly, not just influence it.

2027+

Regional & national elections

First electoral campaigns to establish Ave Europa on the political landscape of member states.

2029

European Parliament Elections

Contesting the 2029 EP elections across as many member states as possible under a single continental party.

A federal structure with local execution, shared infrastructure, and one continental strategy

- National political party registration and compliance
- Local membership, volunteering, and event operations
- Country-specific campaigns in native language
- National marketing leads coordinated with federal
- Local fundraising within EU funding rules

Marketing Communication

AI-assisted content engine, 24 EU languages, human-approved at every gate.



Marketing Surveillance

Real-time narrative monitoring, sentiment scoring, CIB detection and evidence capture.



AI Conversation Companion

A first-class AI participant in meetings: moderation, memory, institutional knowledge.



HoloMeet

3D virtual meeting platform extending governance into immersive environments.



Euro-Demokratie

Neutral civic-accountability infrastructure: proposals, debate, verifiable records.

One platform · Multi-tenant · EU data residency · Open-source first



Why This Can Scale

Ave Europa is not relying on goodwill alone — it is building repeatable political infrastructure



Shared infrastructure

One codebase, one identity system, one data layer — reused across 27 chapters.



AI-assisted operations

Content, translation, moderation, and intelligence without linearly growing headcount.



Institutional memory

Every meeting, decision, and position captured and searchable across the movement.



Real-time situational awareness

Surveillance and sentiment monitoring route alerts to the right team before crises escalate.

- Six specification documents — one per module, reviewed and versioned
- Open-source stack: BigBlueButton, CiviCRM, Keycloak, Mattermost, Nextcloud, Postiz
